

HOW TO INCLUDE CASTE IN CENTRAL GOVERNMENT LIST OF OBC

The National commission for backward classes (NCBC) is constituted to recommend inclusion or exclusion of any caste in central list of OBCs. This commission is entrusted with only single job to recommend inclusion and exclusion of castes.

Procedure to get OBC status in Central Government's list ---

(1) Send an application for inclusion in central list of OBCs on following address-

**Chairman
National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC)
TRIKOOT - 1, BHIKAJI CAMA PLACE, NEW DELHI - 110 066**

(2) The NCBC will send a Questionnaire (prescribed application form to include a caste.) to the applicant, which is also available on website of NCBC on URL given below.

(3) you have to send back this Questionnaire duly filled up with all enclosures required to the NCBC New Delhi.

(4) After that, the Bench of NCBC earmarked for Rajasthan state will visit Jaipur (capital of your state) for "HEARING" and they will call you through Newspaper advertisement.

(5) After such hearing and scrutinizing the inclusion by the "Research wing" of NCBC the NCBC will recommend to Ministry of social Justice and Empowerment Govt of India New Delhi (Now the Minister is Mr. Mukul Wasnik) for inclusion of caste in central list of OBCs.

(6) The Ministry of social Justice and Empowerment Govt of India New Delhi will put up such recommendation before Central Cabinet for approval.

(7) After approval of Central Cabinet the Order to include the caste in central list of OBCs will be issued by Ministry of social Justice and Empowerment Govt of India New Delhi.

Note:-

(1) The above procedure has no connection with any state's department or commission or any recommendation of state govt. This is an independent procedure adopted by NCBC New Delhi.

(2) This is a time taking process as since 12.10.07 (i.e. since 3 years) no caste is included in the central list of OBCs as the Central Gazettes available on www.obcguru.com speaks whereas so many "Hearings" were conducted by the NCBC during this period all over the India.
