

**SELECTION OF OBCs IN UNRESERVED (General) SEATS ON MERIT BASIS:
NO BAR IN AVAILING FURTHER BENIFITS OF RESERVED CATEGORY**

- (1) **Rule:-** “While a reserved category candidate entitled to admission or appointment on the basis of his merit in general (unreserved) seats he will be counted in general seats only and will not be adjusted in reserved seats.” (Para 2(b) of GOI OM Dt. 08.09.1993)
- (2) **Confusion:-** In above situation the OBC candidates get confused and think that now as they are joining the institution as a general candidate they may not be entitle to avail benefits like scholarships, fee concession, loans etc as an OBCs candidate, **THIS IS A WRONG CONCEPT.**
- (3) **Clarification:-** It is to clarify that when a reserved category OBC candidate entitled to admission or appointment on the basis of his merit in general (unreserved) seats he is still entitle to avail all the benefits as a OBCs candidate in which category/caste he has born.
