Respected Sir,

Kindly recall our discussion on phone and personnel meeting with our All India Joint Secretary Dr. Neelesh Mathankar on dated 01.11.2011, we beg to convey you MANY MANY THANKS for correcting software programme of online application form of IIT JEE 2012 for OBC candidates.

Now as an OBC (NCL) candidate darkens the annual income “above Rs. 4.50 lakhs” software does not change his category from “OBC (NCL)” to “General”, which is correct.

As there are 6 rules in Central Govt’s creamy layer criteria Dated 08.09.1993, like rule of ‘post’ for “service category”, rule of ‘land’ for “farmers” & rule of “annual income” for “businessmen” instead of having a single annual income rule (copy available at [www.obcguru.com](http://www.obcguru.com)). Hence income of parents may go above Rs. 4.50 lakhs even for a legal OBC (Non Creamy Layer) candidate.
